### 1.0 Event Information

- 1.1 Name of Event: 2015 Putrajaya Cup National Championships
- 1.2 Venue: Putrajaya Water Sports Complex, Presint 6, Putrajaya; 1.3 Dates: 09-10 Oct 2015
- 1.4 Status: National with International Invitation. All tournament and wakeboard competitors in IWWF Asian Federations are eligible by invitation. This event is part of the National Sports Day celebrations (Hari Sukan Negara)
- 1.5 Homologation: This will be a homologated ranking list (L) event for waterski.
- 1.6 Co-Organisers: Malaysian Waterski & Wakeboard Federation (MWWF) & Waterski & Wakeboard World Cup Sdn. Bhd. (WWWC)

- 1.7 Entries: Entry Fee is RM200 per competitor for any number of events entered. All entries will receive a teeshirt, mineral water & lunches for Friday, & Saturday of event weekend.
- 1.8 Sponsors: Ministry of Youth & Sports Malaysia, Putrajaya Corporation, MyCEB, WWWC, Pullman Hotel Putrajaya & others
- 1.9 Weather / Haze: The Chief Judge may delay the start of any event due to not only inclement weather conditions but will also be due to the unhealthy haze condition under advisement of the event Director. If the API reading is above 130 all participants and officials are advised to wear face masks provided if not competing in the water. Should the API reading be above 130, the Chief Judge may delay the running of any event. For the benefit of competitors and officials airconditioned rooms will be provided at the grandstands and the control tower for their use when not officiating or competing. If the suspension bridge to the north of the ski site is completely not visible it is an indication the API reading is greater than 130.

If due to weather or haze interruptions and if any finals cannot be run, the preliminary round (rd 1) results will be declared by the Chief Judge as the final results.



For waterski, all Rd 1 Competitors will advance to the Finals if the start list is 6 or less. If the start list is more than 6 but not more than 11, 6 will advance into the final. If the start list is between 12 and 15, 9 will advance to the final. For wakeboard LCQs will be run for maximum 6 riders in the finals.

#### 6.0 IWWF Rules

All rules for Waterski will be in accordance to the 2015 IWWF World Tournament Rules unless as modified above. All rules for Wakeboard shall be in accordance to the IWWF World Wakeboard Rules and the Malaysian Wakeboard Rules which are similar to the Singapore Waterski & Wakeboard Federation Wakeboard Rules.
