- **1.4 Status:** National with International Invitation. All tournament, wakeboard and wakesurf competitors in IWWF Asian Federations are eligible by invitations.
- **1.5 Homologation:** This will be a homologated ranking list (L) event for waterski Slalom, Tricks & Jump and a non-ranking list event for wakeboard and wakesurf.
- **1.6 Co-Organisers:** Malaysian Waterski & Wakeboard Federation (MWWF) & Waterski & Wakeboard World Cup Sdn. Bhd. (WWWC).

Novice Mini course Boys & Girls	Any speed / rope length (4 passes max)

3.2 Wakeboard

Novice: No flips/roll, Max trick double wake jump. Open: No limit.

3.3 Wakesurf & Skim Combined

Amateur: Combined surf or skim. No detachment tricks, Max trick 360 spin. No changing board for 2nd pass. Open: No limit. No changing board for 2nd pass.

3.4 Event Format

All waterski events are run in Preliminaries (Rd 1) and Finals (Rd 2) format with Finals results counting towards medal positions. If there should be a tie at the Final, the higher score at Rd 1 breaks the tie. As for the wakeboard and wakesurf events, we will run LCQ if competitors are more than 6 entries.
