The Championship is open to all Malaysians, expatriates resident in Malaysia and Regional skiers and riders from regional IWSF affiliated national associations invited by MWSF.

~~Non Malaysians who are residents in Malaysia may compete in all categories except for the Mini-Course Slalom category and the Novice Wakeboard categories.~~

~~Invited competitors from IWSF affiliated Associations and from Asian countries cannot participate in the Mini-Course Slalom, the Novice Slalom and the Novice Wakeboard categories.~~

~~Men Novice: any speed w/o gates but must start from left of first wake. (cancelled)~~

~~Women Intermediate: 26 mph (cancelled)~~

~~Men Intermediate: 28 mph (cancelled)~~

~~Women Open: 32 mph (cancelled)~~

~~Men Open: 34 mph~~

Mini-Course Slalom

Girls (10 and under): any speed w/o gates but must start from left of first wake.

Boys (10 and under): any speed w/o gates but must start from left of first wake.

Girls (15 and under): any speed w/o gates but must start from left of first wake.

Boys (15 and under): any speed w/o gates but must start from left of first wake.

- **Amalgamated with "Boys (18 and under)".**

Girls (18 and under): any speed w/o gates but must start from left of first wake.

- **Amalgamated with "Women (above 18)".**

Boys (18 and under): any speed w/o gates but must start from left of first wake.

Women (above 18): any speed w/o gates but must start from left of first wake.

Men (above 18): any speed w/o gates but must start from left of first wake.

8.0 Entry Fees

8.1 For all categories: **RM150 per Category** (MWSF Trainees will enjoy 50% discount)
The entry fees will entitle the competitor to one practice run on Friday, one competition run on Saturday and one competition run on Sunday as well as the following benefits:

- One event teeshirt
- Two lunch packs (Saturday & Sunday)
- Mineral water for both days
- And any other vouchers/benefits forthcoming from the organiser/sponsor.

8.2 Entries must be submitted with entry fees to the **“Waterski & Wakeboard World Cup Sdn. Bhd.”** no later than 2 weeks before each round to be received by 5pm by hard copy mail. Email attachment will not be valid as we need the original signature on the entry form and the indemnity form.

8.3 Late entries will be charged a penalty of RM30 per category. **Late entries may not be accepted (even if penalty is paid) if the maximum number of entries for Slalom categories exceed 30 and the maximum number of entries for Wakeboard categories exceed 30.**

8.4 Late entries will close on the Friday before the event at 12noon.

9.0 Awards

For each round, each category or for each amalgamated category competitors will receive the following awards:

- 1st – Gold Medal
- 2nd – Silver medal
- 3rd – Bronze medal

Championship awards will be trophies for the Champion awarded after the final round of the Championship.

10.0 Championship Points

Points shall be awarded for each category with 5 points for 1st, 4 points for 2nd, 3 points for 3rd, 2 points for 4th and 1 point for 5th for each round.
